

## **Community Service Restitution Volunteers**

The Boys & Girls Clubs of Arlington (B&GC) participates in a program to provide meaningful work to individuals who have been assigned **Community Service/Restitution (CSR)** hours by a court or probation official. In turn, the hours served by community service workers provide a labor source which assists the Branches in maintaining facilities and other Boys & Girls Clubs of Arlington property. These specifications explain the program and its procedures.

### **Who may qualify for community service/restitution?**

- Minimum age of 17 years old.
- English language fluency
- Current, pending, or previous offenses which are non-threatening, non-violent, not drug-related, not sex-related, and not a Felony

### **What time is available?**

- May vary Monday- Friday between 11:00 a.m. - 8 p.m.
- Our times will change when AISD or Mansfield ISD are out. It is your responsibility to talk to your Branch Supervisor for to confirm available times.

### **What are the conditions?**

- CSR workers must be initially placed at a Branch by Santiago Saenz or Jean Goodwin-Grisham
- CSR workers must call 24 hours in advance to re-schedule appointments.
- CSR workers must complete the appropriate CSR volunteer application for the B&GC and pass all clearance steps before being placed in a B&GC Center.
- CSR workers who do not show up and do not call in advance will not be able to complete their service at the Boys & Girls Clubs of Arlington.
- CSR workers who are unable to follow directions and perform tasks adequately will not be able to complete their service at the Boys & Girls Clubs of Arlington.
