



VOLUNTEER JOB LISTINGS

All or most of the following jobs can be done as an individual or group. These are just examples of various jobs that have been done in the past. If you have any ideas or suggestions of other skills, classes, or projects you would like to teach or do please feel free to let us know.

Character and Leadership Development – Empowers youth to support and influence their Club and community, sustain meaningful relationships with others, develop a positive self-image, participate in the democratic process and respect their own and others cultural identities.

- **General Instructor** – Help teach classes to youth about the importance of service to Club, community, and family; academic performance; life goals; positive morals and values; etc.
- **Special Class Instructor** – Teach the youth a new technique or talent such as cooking, sewing, juggling, public speaking, etc.

Health and Life Skills – Develops young people’s capacity to engage in positive behaviors that nurture their own well-being, set personal goals and live successfully as self-sufficient adults.

- **General Instructor** – Teach youth about hygiene, etiquette, care of home, care of finances, etc.
- **Prevention Leader** – Help run prevention classes on how to say no to drugs, being assertive, how to be a good friend, prevent early sexual activity, & more . . .

The Arts – Enables youth to develop their creativity and cultural awareness through knowledge and appreciation of the visual arts, crafts, performing arts and creative writing.

- **Choir Director** – Help form choir, instruct youth on singing, reading music, etc.
- **Cultural Awareness Instructor** – Teach the youth about various cultures.
- **Dance/Cheer Instructor** – Help form a dance team and/or cheer squad. Create routines, cheers, etc.
- **Drama Teacher** – Help with drama programs, put on a play, skit, etc.

Sports, Fitness, and Recreation – Develops fitness, positive use of leisure time, skills for stress management, appreciation for the environment and social skills.

- **Environmental Awareness Instructor** – Teach youth about protecting the environment, etc.
- **Games Room Attendant** – Check out equipment, answer phone, and assist Social Rec. Director.
- **Sports Coach** – Coach teams for seasonal sports like basketball or teach youth a new sport such as Karate, Tennis, Golf, etc.

Education and Career Development – Enables youth to become proficient in basic educational disciplines, apply learning to everyday situations, and embrace technology to achieve success in a career.

- **Career Dev. Instructor** - Teach a college prep course, help youth explore various careers, etc.
- **Computer Instructor** – Teach web design, graphics, or general computer knowledge
- **Homework Helper** – Help cooperative learning groups do homework
- **Tutor** – Assist youth with homework one-on-one

Other Projects Groups Might Consider

- Host a Special Event such as Kwanza Fest, Health Fair, Field Day, etc.
- Host a Service Project such as painting the gym, planting flowers, etc.
- Set up a talent show for the Club or get a group of kids to put on a play.
